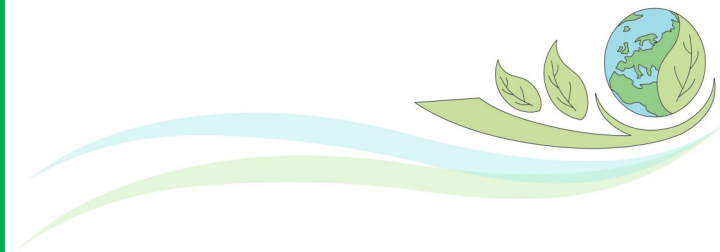

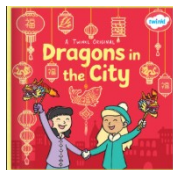

- * Talk about what we have learned and explain our understanding to others and answer how and why questions.



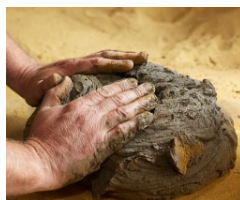
As investigating explorers we will be learning to ...
