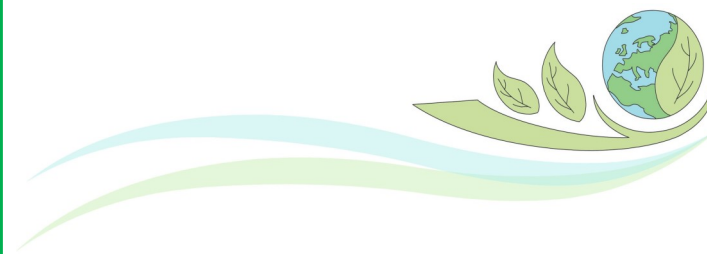

As readers and writers we will be learning to ...

- Write short sentences in meaningful contexts.
- Recognise and write tricky words on sight as well as learning some high frequency words.
- Listen to various stories, anticipate key events and describe the appearance and feelings of main.



As mathematicians we will be learning to ...

- Add and subtract 2 single digit numbers.
