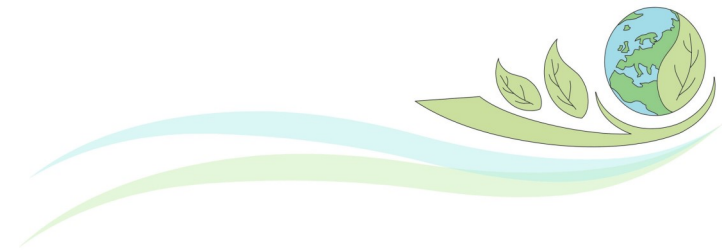

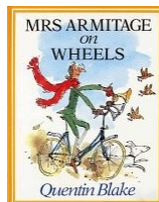

As readers and writers we will be...

- Practising our cursive handwriting style and improving the fluency of our letters
- We will become more confident using upper and lower case letters
- Using adjectives to describe characters and objects
- Continuing to work on sentence structure

As scientists we will be...

- Learning about the four seasons we experience throughout the year
